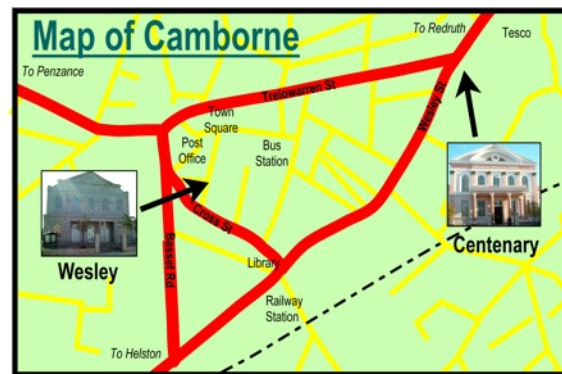

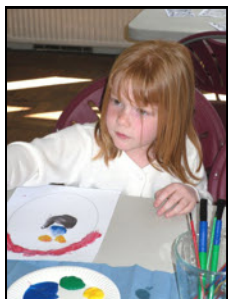

Music plays an important part in our worship. Traditional hymns, contemporary songs, choir and organ, keyboard and band, all contribute to the rich diversity of the church's music tradition.



Holy Communion Holy Communion is shared regularly during each month both on Sundays and at Mid-Week services.

2nd Sunday, Young Families Breakfast and Messy Church, are three contemporary and interactive forms of worship for all ages using crafts, stories and songs to explore the Bible.

Growing in Faith and Exploring

During each week **Groups** meet for Bible study and prayer in order to understand more fully what it means to be a follower of Jesus



Bible Study takes place at the Centenary Centre on alternate Monday evenings. The Prayer Circle meets on a Wednesday Mornings at the Wesley Centre. Wesley Chapel is open for silent prayer on Saturday Mornings. Further prayer and Bible study groups meet across the town at various venues.

You may pop in to the Wesley Centre for a freshly brewed **coffee** and have a slice of home made cake, any time between 10am & 4pm Monday to Friday



Lunch is served on Thursdays in the Centenary Centre & Monday-Friday in the Wesley Centre.

Meals on Wheels are delivered Monday to Friday from the Wesley Centre to those in need at home.

The **Toy Library** for Camborne is now based at the Centenary Centre along with **CPR FoodBank**.

Members of the Church are also actively involved in **Camborne Street Pastors** and **Wavelength** (a listening service).

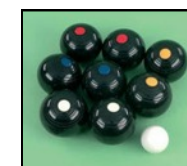
Holiday clubs, film nights, sports events and other social activities are organised for all ages.
